- For every chapter you will have a test. The day before the test we will have a practice test, which will help you to prepare for the final test. Studying for Algebra tests is very important. There are no test retakes.
- You will be taking an End of the Course Practice Exam at the end of 1st and 2nd Quarters. The Official End of Course exam will be mid May.
- You will be taking the Acuity Test for Math once a quarter and the MAP test in April.
